

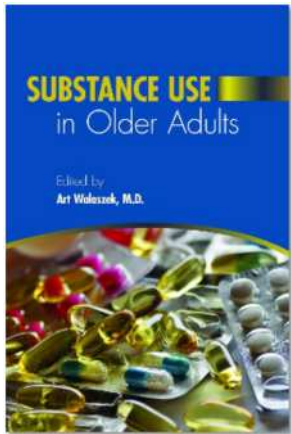

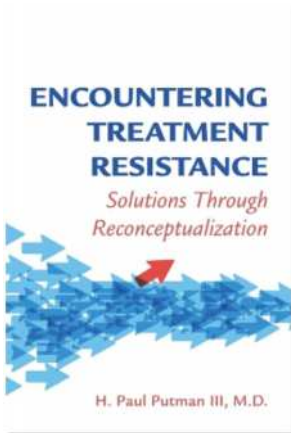
Substance Use in Older Adults

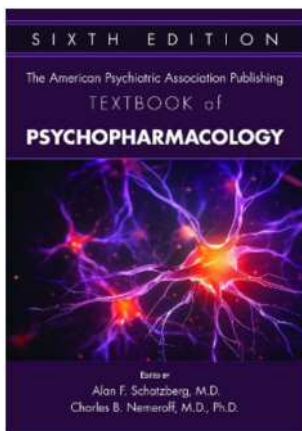
Encountering Treatment Resistance : Solutions Through Reconceptualization

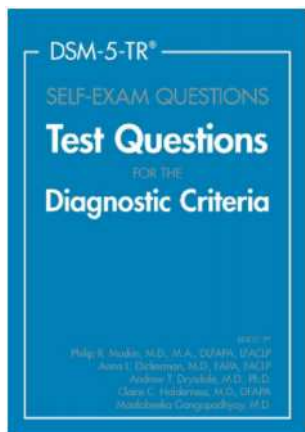
